

Kangra Miniature Painting

Kangra Miniature Paintings are examples of superb and skilled talent exhibited by the artists. The complicated and detailed work involved in making a miniature painting is of great appreciation and value. Miniature Paintings gained importance in the 11th and 12th century when people starting developing manuscripts to store valuable knowledge using palm leaves. A high degree of expertise is required as it involves the use of a very fine brush. The colors used are natural, mainly derived from minerals, vegetables, precious stones, indigo, conch shells, gold, silver, etc., and are obtained through a meticulous process. The district Kangra of Himachal Pradesh is pretty skilled in various crafts and arts. The Kangra School of paintings is an integral part of Himalayan art. The Kangra style became well well-established in the Hills and many offshoots emerged in the regions like Kullu, Nurpur, Chamba, and Mandi. Kangra Miniature Painting has been well acclaimed throughout the world. Painting is done on old or new handmade paper of very fine quality depicting elements of nature, art and architecture, and themes from mythology. It is painstaking effort, skill, and talent of artists but it is declining with the passage of time. There is a need of making an effort to conserve this art from declining and at the same time enhance the skills of the learners who are in actual the future custodian of rich cultural heritage.

About the Workshop

Kalp Foundation, Mandi in collaboration with Pratibha Spandan Society, Shimla are organizing a five-days' online workshop on Kangra Miniature Painting. In this workshop, the learners will study traditional aspects of miniature painting and gain an understanding of the same with professional approaches to still life drawing, figure drawing and tactics of miniature painting. It will promote knowledge of miniature painting which will allow the learners to widen their intuitive interest in the miniature painting. The workshop has been designed keeping in view the practical aspects of Miniature Painting which will polish the creative skills of the learners.

Day 1: Introduction to Kangra Miniature Painting

Day 2: *Tippai*, sketching/ line work

Day 3: Colour making and colouring techniques

Day 4: Shade work

Day 5: Giving a finishing touch to a painting
