

World Environment Day is meant to generate awareness about the significance of nature. The main idea behind celebrating World Environment Day is to realize the importance of the environment and to make people aware that nature should not be taken

He highlighted the present scenario of the air and water quality in the state and the role of state pollution control board in the management of pollution. He talked about various rules and regulations governing

the monitoring of the environment in the state. He also discussed the positive impact of COVID-19 pandemic on environment.

Prof. P. K. Ahluwalia, Former Dean Planning & Teaching Matters, HP University, Shimla delivered his lecture on responsibility of citizens in restoration of environment in the state. He shared the green initiatives taken by the Green New Shimla Society in restoration of





ecosystem at microlevel. Shashi Shekhar, Scientific Officer, Head Office H. P. Pollution Control Board, Shimla enlightened the participants with the use of satellites in environment monitoring & planning. Prof. Keshav Sharma, Former Dean, Department of Education, HP University, Shimla talked about Mind Pollution and

Human Life. He discussed the origin of thought which is the root cause of suffering
